- Visibly declares your deliverance from the judgement of God (1 Peter 3:18-21)
- Displays your union with Christ's body, His Church (Acts 2:26-41; 1 Corinthians 12:12-13; Ephesians 4:3-6)
- Follows both the example (Matthew 3:13-17) and command of Christ (Matthew 28:19)
