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

WEEKLY RECAP

Main Point: God is Holy Bible Passage: Isaiah 6 Bible Story: God Called Isaiah

The prophet Isaiah was granted an encounter with God that few have ever experienced. While in the Temple one day, Isaiah saw one of the most lofty and alorious visions of God in the whole Bible. It is recorded in Isaiah 6. "In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord seated on a high and lofty throne, and the hem of his robe filled the temple. Seraphim were standing above him; they each had six wings: with two they covered their faces. with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. And one called to another: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Armies; his glory fills the whole earth." Biblical authors show how important something is by repeating words. Holy is the only attribute of God that is repeated 3 times in a row. This shows us that Holiness is God's supreme attribute that helps us make sense of all his other traits. God's love is holy love. His presence is Holy presence. His power is Holy power. To be "holy" means to be "set apart". By saying "God is Holy", it means that God is on a completely different level than humans are. He is high and lofty and in a different category than humans. He is so pure and glorious...no one can fully comprehend him. Yet this Holy God still bends his knee to forgive Isaiah's sin and give him clean lips by atoning for his sin in order to make him holy. The apostle John later tells us that Jesus is the one who did this for Isaiah (John 12:9) and he is also the one who will do this for us. Help kids today to understand that a proper response to being in God's holy presence, is worship, repentance, gratitude and a willingness to obey Jesus commands.
